Nueva historia argentina Noemí Goldman, 1998 Este volumen de la Nueva Historia Argentina estudia el proceso abierto por la crisis de la Monarquia española y las guerras de independencia en el Río de la Plata. Revolución, República, Confederación (1806-1852), proporciona al lector un conocimiento global del periodo, al mismo tiempo que revela una historia conflictiva, en los orígenes de la Nación Argentina, de construcción no solo de las formas de organización política sino también de la propia identidad. Asimismo, la cuestión de la soberanía, la emergencia de los estados provinciales, la implantación de un nuevo régimen representativo en Buenos Aires, el proyecto urbano elaborado en la década del 20, las 'identidades federales' en el régimen de Rosas, la Generación del 37 y la construcción de la identidad nacional constituyen en este libro algunos de los temas centrales de investigación reciente que, al tiempo que apuntan a alcanzar una mejor comprensión del proceso histórico, renuevan nuestra visión del periodo de la Independencia.

Asociativa, movilizada, violenta - Tomo I Pablo Vagliente, 2018-03-20 Fruto de casi siete años de investigaciones, este trabajo del historiador Pablo Vagliente se centra en un caso, Córdoba, y un período, 1850-1930, decisivos para entender el zigzagueante curso de la historia argentina en el siglo XX. Lo hace desde un aspecto menos frecuentado, el de la sociedad civil, tanto en sus múltiples maneras de manifestarse en espacios públicos, como en su dinámica asociativa. Así, se aborda el complejo festivo, con la primacía del carnaval, pero también con las modalidades que las colonias de inmigrantes van estableciendo en la ciudad, desde las romerías españolas a las estas italianas del XX de Septiembre, a las que se suman las estas patrias, enfocadas como parte del ascenso cultural del militarismo en la sociedad. El tomo se completa con los análisis de los conflictos en el espacio público, que protagonizan actores de las arenas política, gremial y religiosa y donde el uso permanente de la violencia es una clave de continuidad política, social e institucional, que permite entender mejor uno de los aspectos oscuros de la Argentina contemporánea.

The Desertmakers Javier Uriarte, 2019-10-29 This book studies how the rhetoric of travel introduces different conceptualizations of space and time in scenarios of war during the last decades of the 19th century, in Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay, and Uruguay. By examining accounts of war and travel in the context of the consolidation of state apparatuses in these countries, Uriarte underlines the essential role that war (in connection to empire and capital) has played in the Latin American process of modernization and state formation. In this book, the analysis of British and Latin American travel narratives proves particularly productive in reading the ways in which national spaces are reconfigured, reimaged, and reappropriated by the state apparatus. War turns out to be a central instrument not just for making possible this logic of appropriation, but also for bringing temporal notions such as modernization and progress to spaces that were described — albeit problematically — as being outside of history. The book argues that wars waged against deserts (as Patagonia, the sertão, Paraguay, and the Uruguayan countryside were described and imagined) were in fact means of generating empty spaces, real voids that were the condition for new foundations. The study of travel writing is an essential tool for

understanding the transformations of space brought by war, and for analyzing in detail the forms and connotations of movement in connection to violence. Uriarte pays particular attention to the effects that witnessing war had on the traveler's identity and on the relation that is established with the oikos or point of departure of their own voyage. Written at the intersection of literary analysis, critical geography, political science, and history, this book will be of interest to those studying Latin American literature, Travel Writing, and neocolonialism and Empire writing.

Against Typological Tyranny in Archaeology Cristóbal Gnecco, Carl Langebaek, 2013-10-25 The papers in this book question the tyranny of typological thinking in archaeology through case studies from various South American countries (Venezuela, Colombia, Bolivia, Argentina, and Brazil) and Antarctica. They aim to show that typologies are unavoidable (they are, after all, the way to create networks that give meanings to symbols) but that their tyranny can be overcome if they are used from a critical, heuristic and non-prescriptive stance: critical because the complacent attitude towards their tyranny is replaced by a militant stance against it; heuristic because they are used as means to reach alternative and suggestive interpretations but not as ultimate and definite destinies; and non-prescriptive because instead of using them as threads to follow they are rather used as constitutive parts of more complex and connective fabrics. The papers included in the book are diverse in temporal and locational terms. They cover from so called Formative societies in lowland Venezuela to Inca-related ones in Bolivia; from the coastal shell middens of Brazil to the megalithic sculptors of SW Colombia. Yet, the papers are related. They have in common their shared rejection of established, naturalized typologies that constrain the way archaeologists see, forcing their interpretations into well known and predictable conclusions. Their imaginative interpretative proposals flee from the secure comfort of venerable typologies, many suspicious because of their association with colonial political narratives. Instead, the authors propose novel ways of dealing with archaeological data.

Hunter-Gatherer Behavior Metin I Eren, 2016-05-23 This volume addresses key questions regarding the extent of the Younger Dryas climate event at the end of the Pleistocene and how hunter-gatherer populations worldwide adapted behaviorally and technologically in the face of major climatic change.

War, Spectacle, and Politics in the Ancient Andes Elizabeth N. Arkush, 2022-03-31 Warfare in the pre-Columbian Andes took on many forms, from inter-village raids to campaigns of conquest. Andean societies also created spectacular performances and artwork alluding to war - acts of symbolism that worked as political rhetoric while drawing on ancient beliefs about supernatural beings, warriors, and the dead. In this book, Elizabeth Arkush disentangles Andean warfare from Andean war-related spectacle and offers insights into how both evolved over time. Synthesizing the rich archaeological record of fortifications, skeletal injury, and material evidence, she presents fresh visions of war and politics among the Moche, Chimú, Inca, and pre-Inca societies of the conflict-ridden Andean highlands. Political Landscapes of the Late Intermediate Period in the Southern Andes Alina Álvarez Larrain, Catriel Greco, 2018-04-18 This book studies the relationship between pukaras and their surrounding landscape, focusing on the architectural and settlement variability registered in both contexts. It is the outcome of a symposium held at the XIX National Congress of Argentine Archaeology (San Miguel de Tucuman, August 8-12, 2016) entitled, Pukaras, strategic settlements and dispersed settlements: Political landscapes of the Late Intermediate Period in the Southern Andes. Based on the topics discussed at the event, this book presents nine case studies covering a large geographic area within the Southern Andes (northwestern Argentina, northern Chile and southern Bolivia), and breaking the national barriers that tend to atomize pre-Hispanic landscapes. The respective chapters cover a wide range of themes: from architectural and settlement variability, ways to build and inhabit space, social segmentation and hierarchy; to endemic conflict, analysis of accessibility and visibility, spatiality and temporality of landscapes; as well as new dating. This book goes beyond the Late Intermediate Period (LIP) analyses from the perspective of fortified settlements and material evidence related to war, by placing the focus on how ancient political landscapes were constructed from the relation between the pukaras and other sites as part of the same territory. The methodologies used include pedestrian surveys, photogrammetric surveys with UAVs (unmanned aerial vehicles) or drones, topographic and architectural surveys, excavations of households, ceramic and rock art analysis, and spatial analysis with geographic information systems (GISs). Given the numerous thematic interconnections between the contributions, the Editors have organized the chapters geographically, moving from south to north: from the southern valleys of Catamarca Province in Argentina to Lipez in the southern part of the Bolivian Altiplano, passing through the Calchaqui valleys of Catamarca, the puna and Quebrada de Humahuaca of Jujuy in northwest Argentina and the Antofagasta region in northern Chile. The book provides valuable new theoretical and methodological perspectives on the study of political landscapes of the Late Intermediate Period in the Southern Andes .
