El azar biográfico que mantuvo alejados a los dos poetas durante el período de esta Correspondencia se dio como sigue : Guillén sucede a Salinas en la Sorbona ; gana la cátedra de Murcia (1925) mientras Salinas es catedrático en Sevilla ; en 1927 éste se traslada a Madrid y, entre 1929 y 1931, vive Guillén en Oxford, en otoño de 1936 Salinas marcha al Willesley College, cerca de Boston ; Guillén es en 1939 profesor de la McGill University de Montreal ; en 1940 Salinas pasa a la Johns Hopkins University de Baltimore y, de 1943 a 1946, a la de Puerto Rico ; en 1947 Guillén es profesor en Yale, regresa a Europa y, por unos días, a España ; Salinas , en cambio, viaja a Colombia, Ecuador y Perú, y, en 1949, a Italia y Francia ; en 1950 Guillén está en el Colegio de México y, al año siguiente, visita otra vez España mientras Salinas permanece en Boston hasta su muerte.
