Estética y pragmática del relato fantástico Juan Herrero Cecilia,2000 La estética del relato fantástico constituye un reto especial para la mentalidad racionalista del lector contemporáneo y, al mismo tiempo, ejerce sobre él una desconcertante y sutil fascinación, porque este género literario cultiva la sensación de inquietante extrañeza poniendo en confrontación y en ambigua confusión lo vivido y lo soñado, lo natural y lo sobrenatural, lo racional y lo irracional. Al situar al lector dentro de la extraña e inexplicable experiencia vivida por el personaje en el mundo de la ficción, el género de lo fantástico nos hace percibir el lado oculto de las fuerzas misteriosas que dirigen el dinamismo profundo de la vida y explora las dimensiones supraracionales de la enigmática identidad del ser humano. Con los estudios recogidos en este libro, el autor ha puesto de relieve las principales características que constituyen la dimensión estética, dialógica y pragmática del género fantástico. Cortázar y Che Guevara Soledad Pérez-Abadín Barro, 2010 El cuento Reunión de Cortázar imprime un giro en la trayectoria de este escritor, para dar paso a los contenidos políticos hasta entonces ausentes de su obra. Esta nueva dimensión añade atractivo a este relato, que evoca la revolución cubana a partir de los capítulos del diario de Ernesto Che Guevara. Para convertir estos escritos políticos en literatura, Cortázar combina algunas estrategias eficaces para sugerir la profunda identificación del escritor con el personaje histórico. En la génesis y desarrollo del cuento, Cortázar, Che Guevara y Mozart entablan con sus obras un juego de equilibrio y tensión que el presente análisis se propone reconstruir.

El cuento literario en España y su exemplificación en relatos breves de Francisco Ayala. Teorías y crítica (1950-2000) Alicia María Valverde Velasco, 2006-06-30 Durante el siglo XIX el cuento comienza a adquirir categoría de género literario en el ámbito de las letras españolas. Las primeras reflexiones de carácter crítico y teórico sobre el cuento literario lo distancian del cuento folclórico o tradicional y tratan de establecer algunas características distintivas, como la fijación escritural, el interés por cuidar el lenguaje literario y la apertura del género a la temática realista. Después de la guerra civil, se retoma el cultivo del cuento literario en España, cuyo momento de más auge había tenido lugar a principios del siglo XX. Desde la década de los cincuenta este género de la literatura ha ido desarrollándose en diversos campos, tanto el creativo como el de la crítica y la teoría, hasta llegar a nuestros días como una modalidad narrativa reconocida entre los lectores y entre un sector de la investigación de la literatura española, tanto dentro como fuera de nuestras fronteras, cuyos principales trabajos constituyen el corpus de este estudio. El principal objetivo de esta tesis es mostrar la existencia de un campo de estudio circunscrito al cuento literario. Un estimable número de aportaciones sobre la epistemología de este género aparecían dispersas en el espacio de la crítica y la teoría española, cuando, en realidad, eran importantes no sólo los puntos de contacto entre ellas sino también el exponerlas conjuntamente para contrastar reflexiones y análisis sobre el cuento literario. Con esa finalidad se constituye la primera parte de este trabajo de investigación. Un segundo y no menos importante objetivo era el

de canalizar esos esfuerzos investigadores para trazar una plataforma teórica y metodológica articulada por la semiótica, lo que ocupa la segunda parte de este trabajo de investigación. Nuestro método de estudio pone en relación la teoría de Lotman sobre el texto artístico con las contribuciones citadas en la tesis, de manera que el cuento literario es estudiado como un tipo de texto artístico-literario en el que se combinan el lenguaje poético, los recursos de la poesía, con el lenguaje narrativo. Tras plantear un modelo de análisis de base lotmaniana que permitiese integrar otras aportaciones al respecto para el estudio de un cuento literario dado, llegamos a la caracterización de este género citada anteriormente, a la que se añaden otros rasgos importantes como la brevedad, el encuadre (limitación estructural del contenido) y la verticalidad (unidad semántico-estructural en relación con la ficción del texto, pero profundidad semántica, que abre las posibilidades de sentido). Varios relatos breves de Francisco Ayala son el objeto de análisis que sirve para ejemplificar los planteamientos expuestos. La conclusión a la que llegamos es que las interesantes reflexiones y análisis sobre el cuento literario recogidas en la tesis resultan útiles, en su conjunto, para la teoría del cuento, por ello son analizadas a través de nuestro propio método semiótico y expuestas cronológicamente, observando no sólo las influencias y desarrollo de este campo de estudio de la narrativa sino también las posibilidades de avances en el mismo. Con ello hemos querido contribuir al estudio del cuento literario.
