José Antonio Ramos Sucre y el heroísmo de la "Ilíada" Berta Guerrero Almagro,2019-03-23 Este libro analiza la poesía en prosa de José Antonio Ramos Sucre (1890-1930) desde el concepto de heroísmo sustentado la Ilíada. Los ecos de la literatura europea en La torre de Timón (1925), Las formas del fuego (1929) y El cielo de esmalte (1929) permiten establecer

una cartografía ramoscreana desplegada sobre un soporte metafórico: los tres estadios en el camino de la vida expuestos por Sören Kierkegaard -estético, ético y religioso-. Si se atiende al sujeto ramoscreano, dichas etapas pueden contemplarse de modo progresivo y simultáneo: el artista -sujeto poético y especie de representación de su creador- concita las figuras del combatiente y el asceta, pero al mismo tiempo se inclina por los héroes de marcada juventud en su etapa inicial. Vivimos tiempos de aceleración e impaciencia, de privatización, de obsolescencia programada, donde las cosas duran poco más que el magro interés que suscitan en un público ávido de novedad. El mundo desaparece en un voraz torbellino de urgencias. No parecen tiempos para el estudio. Sin embargo, quizás sea precisamente esta condición actual la que hace del estudio una noción intempestivamente contemporánea. Un claro laberinto Lelio Fernández Druetta,2023-05-11 A lo largo de estas cuatro notas hay espacios de reflexión sobre algunas cuestiones y algunos esbozos de críticas. Casi todos, si es que no todos, reflejan momentos de conversaciones con estudiantes y con colegas. A veces dejan entrever un tinte didáctico que es, en algunos lugares, reiteración intencionada. En más de un lugar, me ocupo de poner en evidencia lo que hace Sennett o lo que hacen los otros autores al escribir sobre tales o cuales cosas. Trato de llamar así la atención sobre cómo ellos construyen textos que nosotros leemos. Eso nace de un persistente interés por la creación de condiciones favorables para algunas experiencias necesarias de lectura: las que se viven al descubrir la organización de un texto, su trama total y la de cada una de sus partes. Al mismo tiempo, es un modo de responder a la queja profesoral frecuente sobre la lectura y la escritura de los estudiantes. Con respecto a lo primero, la experiencia de la lectura, todos sabemos lo bueno que resulta leer cuando, en lugar de conformarnos con quedar más o menos enterados de lo que dice el texto, tratamos de darnos cuenta de cuál es la estrategia y cuáles son las tácticas que dan forma, sentido y alcance a lo que leemos. Eso siempre es necesario en escritos a los que vale la pena dedicar una detenida atención. Es un modo de hacer que lo que leemos no sea un flujo de palabras, una corriente de frases, una cascada de páginas. Es una forma de leer que, si va acompañada de simpatía, o al menos de interés, hace que el autor sea una realidad humana. Aun cuando el diálogo con él no sea posible, esa lectura atenúa algunos efectos de la imposibilidad. Con respecto a lo segundo: con los estudiantes he aprendido desde hace años que la queja profesoral, de por sí inútil y a veces injusta, se hace progresivamente innecesaria cuando, juntos, consolidamos el hábito de leer de ese modo (Notas sobre el carácter y su corrosión). Al igual que el cuadro de Rembrandt El filósofo en meditación fue un buen apoyo para la imaginación de Borges ('Recuerdos de unas experiencias de lectura'), algunos textos de Patón, Aristóteles, Maquiavelo, Spinoza, Hobbes, Freud, Mignini, Negri, Sennett, Dworkin, Schmitt y Schlink lo son para el interés por la creación de condiciones favorables para algunas experiencias de lectura'.

Verdad, historia y posverdad Miguel Giusti,2020-08-01 La verdad ha pasado a ocupar recientemente un lugar protagónico en los debates de la opinión pública, en particular en su forma devaluada de posverdad. Los animales en los Beatos Nadia Mariana Consiglieri, 2022-11-11 Los Beatos fueron un particular género codicológico que prosperó entre el siglo X y la primera mitad del XIII. Su contenido fue el Comentario al Apocalipsis escrito por un monje oriundo de tierras cántabras activo a fines del siglo VIII: Beato de Liébana. La Península Ibérica fue el área geográfica predilecta para la reproducción de esta obra en diversos scriptoria monásticos, aunque también se confeccionaron copias en suelo itálico y francés. El trabajo itinerante de miniaturistas que llevaron consigo compilaciones de modelos y diseños quedó plasmado en la ideación y configuración de las figuras zoomorfas que pueblan los folios de estos manuscritos iluminados. Pese a que los motivos iconográficos apocalípticos básicos se reiteran en toda la serie, sus soluciones pictóricas fueron cambiando conceptual y materialmente a través de esos siglos. No solo por su cantidad sino por su complejo desarrollo, la imaginería de animales en los Beatos se basó en una retórica visual particular y variable que buscó influir en la lectio monástica. Persuadir, convencer, comprender y preservar en la memoria de los monjes los principales contenidos exegético-apocalípticos fueron los propósitos de estas constelaciones animalísticas, que construyeron un discurso visual paralelo al del relato textual, nutriéndolo y tensionándolo con otras significaciones. Estos animales no actuaron como meras figuras

aleatorias, ilustrativas o decorativas del texto, sino que operaron a través de una efectiva retórica visual estructurada en la polaridad bien-mal para reforzar y ampliar los sentidos del Comentario reproducido en estos manuscritos por casi cuatro siglos. Tradujeron a nivel exegético-doctrinal lo sagrado y lo diabólico sobre la base de los polos domesticación- salvajismo/bestialidad, presentes en la clasificación faunística de las *Etymologiae* de Isidoro de Sevilla. Además, dialogaron con los zoomorfismos presentes en la cultura visual de sus entornos monásticos, incorporando incluso interesantes observaciones empíricas sobre diversas especies.
