Once inside, it will be preferable to keep one's eyes open in order to understand where one sets foot, yet not to neglect to close them so as to be able to wander off beyond its borders. This neither-too-long, neither-tooshort book is also a body: a hybrid body composed of heterogeneous worlds and points of view, assembled according to the "good neighbour" principle, so cherished by Aby Warburg. It compiles fragments of texts uprooted from their original context, some of which are published as a whole, others devised within the framework of the exhibition. It also contains images, some speechless, others quite talkative, which, again, have been deterritorialised - moved out of their original context - in order to become reterritorialised in new surroundings.
