Segundo, el libro se centra en los problemas especiales de las transiciones a la democracia de sistemas comunistas. En otras palabras, no habrá país "normal" si no se cuida de tener una transición exitosa. Este libro pretende aislar dichos problemas especiales de las transiciones, sus causas raíz y sus consecuencias, y presentar las diferentes experiencias de cómo las treinta y dos transiciones del mundo post-comunista eurasiático se enfrentaron a dichos problemas, y los resultados empíricos de dichas acciones. Este libro deviene, en realidad, en tres. Las primeras dos secciones, Reformas y Resultados, hacen un análisis académico de las acciones que tomaron los reformadores en los países donde llegaron al poder y tuvieron su oportunidad de actuar.
