Genogramas en la evolución familiar Mónica McGoldrick, Randy Gerson, 2021-06-11 El genograma es una forma gráfica de organizar la masa de información reunida durante una evaluación familiar y de hallar pautas en el sistema familiar total. Sin embargo, hasta ahora, se ha utilizado de modo poco estructurado y tanto las hipótesis generadas por los supuestos fundamentales cuanto los resultados derivados del uso clínico han sido confusos. Los autores han remediado esa situación al presentar un formato uniformado para la construcción del genograma y señalar los principios que sustentan su interpretación y aplicación. El texto cobra vida para el lector en los genogramas de familias famosas, como las de Sigmund Freud, Margaret Mead, Gregory Bateson, Virginia Woolf, Eugene O'Neill, Jane Fonda, John F. Kennedy y Thomas Jefferson, entre otras. Una vez que los autores han presentado la teoría de los sistemas familiares y explicado las entrevistas sistemáticas, exemplificando todo con genogramas, pasan a la presentación de las aplicaciones clínicas en la terapia y en la medicina familiar; asimismo exploran nuevas fronteras, en particular el uso de genogramas generados por computadora. McGoldrick y Gerson han logrado lo imposible: nos han dado una descripción elaborada y completa sobre cómo reunir, interpretar y utilizar clínicamente la información sobre el proceso familiar que aparece en un genograma bien trazado y, además, han logrado que el libro sea ameno utilizando familias famosas para ilustrar sus presentaciones.
