Poesía completa José Lezama Lima,2022-11-23 Este primer tomo de la Poesía completa de José Lezama Lima contiene las obras de su primera etapa. En ellas Lezama construye su concepción de la poesía. La trayectoria poética de Lezama se inicia muy pronto, cuando apenas cuenta veintisiete años. En 1937 publicó un extenso poema, que había compuesto años atrás, y que lleva por título Muerte de Narciso. Muerte de Narciso, en su particular universo, expresa y contiene su propuesta estética. En él el autor dialoga con la herencia literaria que lo inspira en la búsqueda de nuevos horizontes de expresión. Lezama manifiesta a través de la imagen de Narciso la construcción de un linaje poético y de una expresión auténtica y propia. Este poema hace equivalencias entre la concepción estética de Góngora y la de Valéry, centrada en el lenguaje poético. Reivindica también la figura de Garcilaso De la Vega como emblema de la actitud del poeta y retoma la negación de

la actitud narcisista, tal como lo hacen las fuentes clásicas del mito. Narciso, el joven enamorado de su imagen, el poeta, atraviesa el espejo para construir su propio ascenso, su propia concepción de la literatura. Después vendrán el resto los poemarios aquí reunidos: Enemigo rumor (1941), Aventuras sigilosas(1945), y La fijeza (1949). El agua es uno de los elementos centrales en Enemigo rumor como lo es en Muerte de Narciso. Esto, llevado a un plano metafísico, se puede interpretar como un deseo posesivo de conocimiento poético. Sin embargo, éste es un deseo que nace frustrado, porque la poesía, como el agua, no se deja atrapar, se escapa en el instante en el que alcanza su mejor definición. En Aventuras sigilosas Lezama se mantiene dentro de las coordenadas de la realidad poética de sus obras anteriores. Sin embargo, en este libro se aprecian ya los primeros signos del sistema poético lezamiano. El texto tiene una especie de introducción, titulada «El Puerto», en la que se plasman los elementos centrales que después serán poetizados: la madre, la esposa, el hijo y las mujeres. La fijeza es un paso más allá en el camino que recorre Lezama. Avanza en su intento de hacer de la poesía un sistema que nos revele un mundo nuevo, cuya causalidad es la de las conexiones poéticas. Queremos terminar comentando que no hemos querido prologar nuestras ediciones de Lezama Lima. Creemos que la obra de un autor como el nuestro no obedece a una perspectiva única. En todo caso publicaremos una bibliografía sugiriendo a los lectores los mejores ensayos de interpretación que sobre Lezama se han escrito. La Poesía completa de José Lezama Lima deberá acompañarse algún día con una biografía de Lezama, libro necesario y actualmente inexistente.

La fijeza José Lezama Lima,2022-11-23 En 1949 el escritor cubano Jorge Mañach agradeció a José Lezama Lima en una carta pública el regalo de un ejemplar de su libro de poemas La fijeza, editado en «esas bellas ediciones de la revista Orígenes, que usted viene dirigiendo desde hace algunos años con heroísmo y prestigio sumos». Por entonces ya Lezama era una figura en el panorama literario cubano y reivindicaba su parcela en él, con sus particularidades inherentes. Había madurado también su sistema poético, que, en La fijeza alcanza un esplendor que luego quedará reforzado en sus ensayos. El título evoca el barroco de Góngora. La fijeza es «el tiempo que resisten los objetos ante la luz», dice Lezama en referencia al concepto gongorino. En La fijeza debate la posibilidad, anhelada por Lezama, de un creación verbal, en cuyo acto quede abolida la causalidad. El poeta no se conforma con la contemplación de la realidad aparente, lo que el autor quiere reflejar es «el eterno reverso enigmático de la cosas». Poemas como: Rapsodia para el mulo Muerte del tiempo Procesión Tangencias Éxtasis de la sustancia destruida Resistencia Son un paso más allá en el camino que recorre Lezama. Aquí el autor avanza en su intento de hacer de la poesía un sistema que nos revele un mundo nuevo, cuya causalidad es la de las conexiones poéticas. Asimismo, entre otros poemas más herméticos, estos destacan por la cadencia con que la voz del poeta nos lleva a su mundo.

Fragmentos a su imán José Lezama Lima,2022-11-23 José Lezama Lima murió el 9 de agosto de 1976, horas antes de que Fragmentos a su imán saliese de la imprenta. Su viuda recibió un ejemplar de este libro, al llegar a su casa tras el entierro del poeta. Fragmentos a su imán es una colección de poemas íntimos, armados en una tensión entre lo cotidiano y lo trascendente; cercanos y, en cierto modo, coloquiales; tocados también por una humildad melancólica y por la sensación íntima del autor de que la muerte lo rondaba muy de cerca. Viaje Alrededor del Mundo Martín Ignacio Loyola, 2011-08-31 Martín Ignacio de Mallea Loyola nació en Éibar (Guipúzcoa) a mediados del siglo XVI. Era hijo de Andrés Martínez de Mallea y de María Osoa de Loyola. Sobrino del fundador de la Compañía de Jesús, Ignacio de Loyola y primo del gobernador de Chile, Martín García de Oñaz. Fue fraile franciscano descalzo, navegante y misionero. Dio la vuelta al mundo dos veces y escribió varios libros que tuvieron gran influencia. Martín inició su primer viaje el 13 de junio de 1581 a México y llegó hasta Filipinas en 1582. De Filipinas pasó a China para evangelizar pero sufrió varios ataques que casi le cuestan la vida. Por entonces Martín fue ayudado por Arias González de Miranda, capitán mayor de Macao. Martín llegó a Europa en 1584 y se puso en contacto con el Consejo de Indias para tratar los problemas que tenían las misiones franciscanas en el Extremo Oriente. En 1594 partió otra vez para América del Sur donde fue nombrado obispo de Paraguay el 19 de noviembre de 1601. Pronto convocó el sínodo de Asunción o

Rioplatense, el primer sínodo que se realizaba en Paraguay, para la buena enseñanza de la doctrina cristiana a los naturales. Este sínodo supuso notables mejoras de la situación de los indígenas y determinó que la evangelización fuese en lengua guaraní. Martín murió unos años después en Buenos Aires, Argentina, el 9 de junio de 1606.
