Aun así, pese a parecer esta meta un sueño inalcanzable, ello no debe convertirse en impedimento para llevar a cabo todas aquellas medidas y planes de intervención que se precisen para conseguir tan anhelado objetivo. Actuaciones estas respaldadas y sustentadas, como no podía ser de otra manera, por un riguroso conocimiento empírico. Así pues, tras un pormenorizado y estructurado examen de los procesos implicados y de las posibles causas que intervienen en el controvertido estudio de la delincuencia habitual, el presente trabajo de investigación trata, por un lado, de ofrecer una amplia visión en cuanto al modo de entender este problema y, por otro, una distintiva manera de abordar su tratamiento penal y penitenciario en atención a los nuevos avances llevados a cabo en el campo de la neurociencia en esta materia.

En suma, los autores profundizan en este libro en un diálogo entre las ciencias y la doctrina filosófica y jurídica relativa a la responsabilidad penal.

Por decirlo en otras palabras, la mayoría de las personas con un trastorno mental, sobre todo si están adecuadamente tratadas y cuentan con un apoyo familiar y social, no son violentas. No se justifica, por ello, el recelo social existente. Rasgo antisocial y afecto positivo y negativo en población penitenciaria de México Dr. Ferrán Padrós Blázquez, Lic. Víctor Edgar Soria Benítez, Lic. Laura Patricia Rafael Hernández, Lic. Sandra María Villegas Castillo, El presente artículo tiene como objetivo estudiar la relación entre la sintomatología de Trastorno Antisocial de Personalidad (TAP) y los niveles de afecto positivo y negativo en reclusos mexicanos. Se utilizó una muestra de 65 reclusos varones, posteriormente se dividió en 2 submuestras, una compuesta por 28 participantes con probable TAP y la otra de 37, compuesta por reos con elevadas

probabilidades de no cumplir con los criterios de TAP. La estimación del diagnóstico de TAP se realizó a partir de la escala ETAPA de Aluja, que evalúa la presencia de sintomatología de TAP, el afecto positivo y negativo fue evaluado mediante las escalas PANAS. Se observó correlaciones significativas entre la puntuación de la escala ETAPA y el afecto positivo (baja y negativa) y con el afecto negativo (moderada y positiva). Además, los reclusos con probable TAP mostraron mayor nivel de afecto negativo y menor afecto positivo que el grupo con probable no TAP. Los resultados obtenidos coinciden parcialmente con lo hallado en estudios previos donde se evaluó la psicopatía. El presente estudio supone una primera aproximación sobre la relación entre los afectos positivo y negativo y el TAP en México.
