Der Koran Allah, 2019-02-25 Der Koran ist der heilige Text des Islam. Für Muslime ist es das Wort des einen Gottes. Der Koran wurde dem letzten Propheten und Boten Muḥammad (ﷺ) aus dem Jahr 610 bis zu seinem Tod 632 von dem Engel Gabriel (جبرائيل) offenbart. Dieses vorliegende Werk ist eine Übersetzung der Bedeutung der Koranverse ins Deutsche.

Islam in German East Africa, 1885-1918 Jörg Haustein, 2023-07-14 In this rich and multi-layered deconstruction of German colonial engagement with Islam, Jörg Haustein shows how imperial agents in Germany's largest colony wielded the knowledge category of Islam in a broad set of debates, ranging from race, language, and education to slavery, law, conflict, and war. These representations of 'Mohammedanism', often invoked for particular political ends, amounted to a serious misreading of Muslims in East Africa, with significant long-term effects. As the first in-depth account of the politics of Islam in German East Africa, the book makes an essential contribution to the history of religion in Tanzania before British rule. Der Koran besteht aus 114 Kapiteln (Suren) und über 6200 Versen. Er wurde 610 nach Christus bis 632 n.C. von dem Engel

Cebraïl (Gabriel) jeweils in Teilen dem Propheten Mohammed offenbart. Die weiteren Teile des Korans wurden durch Gott an Mohammed weitergegeben. Mohammed lernte die Texte auswendig und diktierte sie den Schreibern unter seinen Gefährten, die sie schriftlich festhielten. Seine Verwandten und Gefährten lernten die Texte des Korans auswendig und vermittelten sie ihren Nächsten. Der Inhaltstext des Korans wurde auf diese Weise schriftlich und mündlich an die arabische Bevölkerung überliefert und schließlich in der Welt verbreitet. Der Islam ist der jüngste und letzte große Glaube der Welt und bezeichnet die Religion, die der Prophet Mohammed begründete. Islam bedeutet übersetzt Frieden finden durch Hingabe an Gott. European Traditions in the Study of Religion in Africa Ulrich Berner, Christoph Bochsinger, 2004 This volume comprises case studies of five centuries of European encounters with and imaginations of Africa encompassing her triple religious heritage: African Traditional Religions, Christianity and Islam. German, Jew, Muslim, Gay Marc David Baer, 2020-04-28 Hugo Marcus (1880–1966) was a man of many names and many identities. Islam Jean Jacques Waardenburg, 2002 This book presents some twenty essays on different aspects of Islam in history and the present. These essays are grouped into eight larger sections.
