Atlas ilustrado de los pueblos de indios, Nueva España, 1800 Dorothy Tanck de Estrada, 2006-11-21 El propósito de este Atlas es determinar y ubicar en mapas los pueblos de indios que existían en 1800 dentro del espacio geográfico de las intendencias de la Nueva España. Con él se espera que, al ver los pueblos de indios esparcidos en todo el territorio virreinal, el lector no sólo encuentre información y datos interesantes acerca del pasado, sino que le surjan nuevas preguntas, interpretaciones e inquietudes respecto del desarrollo local, regional y nacional de ayer y hoy.
