memory of the freedom struggle during that very era. In their use of a postblack ethos to enact African American subjectivity, the plays envision black identity beyond the quest for freedom, anticipating what blackness might look like when it moves beyond the struggle. The plays under discussion range from the canonical (Lorraine Hansberry's *A Raisin in the Sun* and Amiri Baraka's *Dutchman*) to celebrated, yet understudied works (Alice Childress's *Wine in the Wilderness*, Howard Sackler's *The Great White Hope*, and Charles Gordone's *No Place to Be Somebody*). Finally, Davis discusses recent revivals, showing how these 1960s plays shape dimensions of modern drama well beyond the decade of their creation.

Voicing the Text Petra Ragnerstam, 2016-08-17 Why is voice so important to us? How does the concept of voice encompass such disparate practices as vocal sound, marks on a page, identity production and the execution of power? With these questions in mind, this book studies voice as both a textual and a bodily phenomenon.
