What Is it Like to Be Dead? Jens Schlieter, 2018-08-06 Studies of near-death experiences show that such experiences not only provide a new certainty of post-mortem survival, but often function as a call for fundamental change in the present. This study is the first to document and analyze four centuries of near-death testimonies before the codification of the genre in the 1970s, offering the first full account of the modern genealogy of near-death experiences.
